GRANTED! NEW LEGAL PROTECTIONS FOR PHYSICIANS FIGHTING COVID-19

We are pleased to inform you that Governor J.B. Pritzker has issued an executive order granting all physicians working at the coronavirus pandemic frontlines immunity from civil liability. The order extends throughout the public health emergency.
