This CME program will examine RVU based productivity models and provide insight on compensation models affected by the ACA. Today, physician productivity and compensation are moving toward models based on Relative Value Units (RVUs). RVUs reflect the relative level of time, skill, training and intensity required of a physician to provide a given service. RVUs therefore are a method for calculating the volume of work or effort expended by a physician in treating patients. The increased use of RVU has been highly significant and appears to be expanding. This rapid growth has caused a gap in the learning curve for many doctors and administrators who may never have had in-depth exposure to RVU-based compensation formulas.
